WEED PREVENATIVE AND LAWN CARE

Weed preventative treatments will begin within the **first two weeks of May**. All lots will be treated unless communicated otherwise to the office.

We ask that your lawns be kept below 3 inches over the summer, and are kept trimmed around home, driveways and walkways. Please do not leave clippings in the street, dispose yard waste in the brown yard waste bags.

ANNUAL TAXES

Reminder to verify the taxes on your home/garage have been paid. You can easily check this at https://pay.iowataxandtags.org. Payments are due every March & September. Don't lose your property to a tax sale!

UPDATE YOUR INFORMATION AT THE OFFICE

Do we have all of your current information? Do you have a new: PHONE, VEHICLE, PET, ROOMMATE, or CHILDREN OVER 18? If you have anything new in your household, please stop by the office to add that information to your file. All of this information is required as per your lease agreement. If you have any questions, please contact the office.

INSURANCE DOCUMENTATION

Proof of homeowner's liability Insurance is **REQUIRED for all homes, & is to be present in your file** at the office. If you have not yet contacted your agent to **add Park View as an "additional Interest"** on your policy, please do so. This will ensure we get the information we need, provided to us automatically, upon your renewal each year.

WE DO NOT ALLOW FIREWORKS

As a reminder, we do not allow fireworks of any kind in the community. This is a fire hazard that could be catastrophic to our homes, given the close proximity to each other. We appreciate your understanding.

VEHICLE AND PARKING REMINDER

There is no parking on streets or in the grass. Streets must be clear for emergency vehicles. Over flow parking can be found various places in the park. If you are paring in an unauthorized area, your vehicle will be tagged for towing at the violator's expense. Please be sure all vehicles have been registered, and are in good working order (without need of repairs).

Trim voluntary trees/weeds away from utilities & skirting. Power washing dirt/mold off siding, skirting & deck.

If you are thinking of making these types of improvements must be approved by the office prior to you beginning the project, & most will require a permit that can be obtained through the city.
